This informational packet has been provided to aid you in your decision prior to making an application to our Apprenticeship Program.

Please review all the information contained within this packet.

1. A copy of the Qualifications for Apprenticeship.
2. A copy of Apprenticeship Program Participation.
3. A copy of the Rules and Policies.
4. A copy of the Joint Apprenticeship Selection Procedure.
5. A sample copy of the Application Form. This form must be filled out in person at this office. Applications are taken every 3rd Friday of each month from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM during business hours at IBEW Local 56, 185 Pennbriar Drive, Erie, PA 16509.
6. The following will be required at the time of the application:
 - A. A \$30.00 payment. Either a check made out to the E.E.T.F. or cash.
 - B. A High School Transcript.
 - C. An approved document of a passing grade in Algebra.
 - D. A copy of your High School Diploma or G.E.D.
 - E. A copy of your Birth Certificate.
 - F. A copy of your Valid Drivers License.
 - G. Any official documentation (payroll records, notarized letters of experience confirmation and sworn statement stating that 8000 hours were specifically worked in the Electrical Construction Trade. (See Item J on Qualifications for Apprenticeship).
 - H. Individuals who have worked a minimum of 4000 hours as a Residential Wireman under an IBEW/NECA Local Collective Bargaining Agreement will qualify for an oral interview by the J.A.C. to be considered along with other qualified applicants. (See item K. on Qualifications for Apprenticeship.)
 - I. Must provide official documentation of all records to the J.A.C. including a copy of the Apprenticeship Agreement properly registered by the appropriate Registration Agency. (See item L. on Qualifications for Apprenticeship).
